1. Everyone is **unique**. We are all different to one another because of our hair colour, eye colour, skin colour, gender, and family. Being different makes us special and individual.



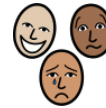
2. I can recognise the feelings happy, sad, angry, scared, calm, worried and frustrated.
