5. Physical features are natural. In Nottingham, some physical features are:

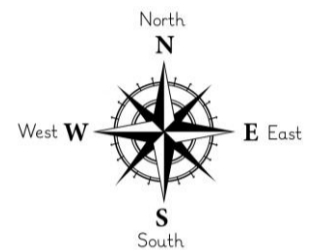
- Sherwood Forest

19. Safely means without being hurt. To cut food safely, our fingers should not be near the knife blade.


















	valley	a valley is a lower part in the land that sits between two higher parts which might be hills or mountains.
	coast	where the land meets the sea.
	ocean	a huge area of salt water between land.
	sea	a big area of salt water between land. Part of an ocean.
	human features	things that are made or built by humans like a canal or castle.
	physical features	things that are naturally made like rivers and forests.
	cathedral	a large church where Christian people worship.
	population	the number of people living in a certain place.
