1. Great Britain is an island surrounded by 3 main seas; English Channel, Irish Sea, North Sea.

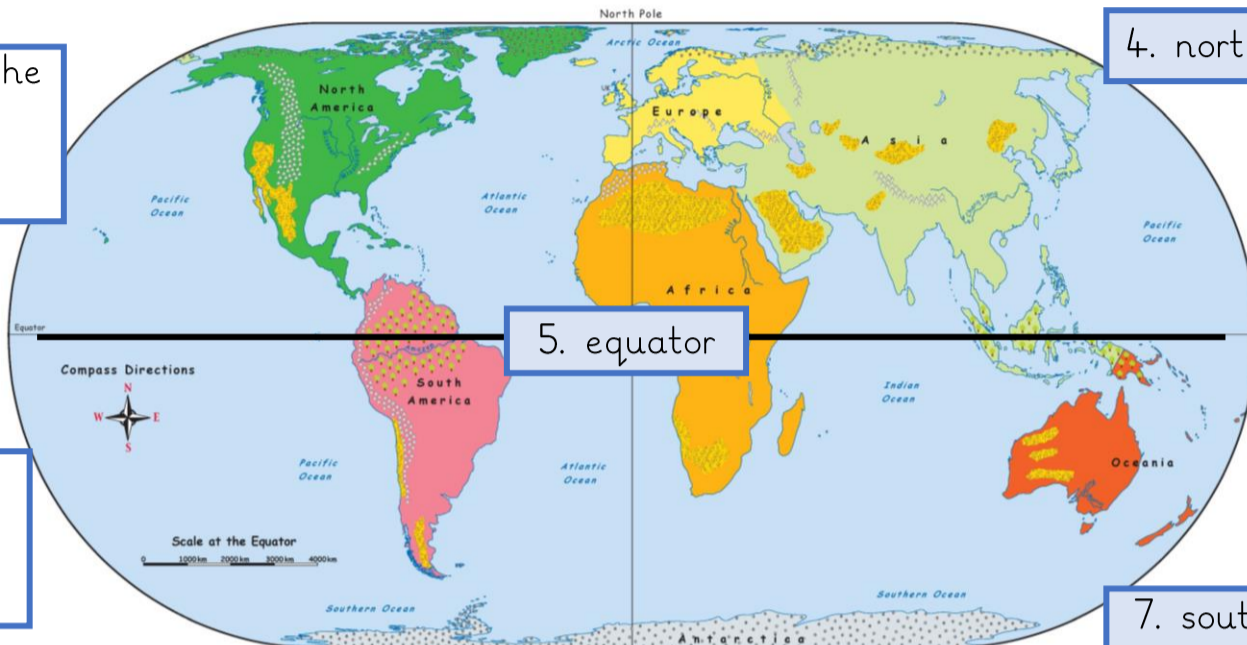


2. The UK is not an island because Northern Ireland is across the Irish Sea.

8. There are 7 continents in the world:

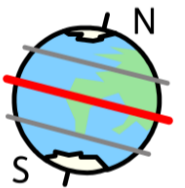
- North America
